President

Leads and schedules meetings and must be named on the guild bank accounts.

Assistant to the President; maintains the membership roster; large scale correspondences; assumes Presidential role if the President becomes unavailable.

Vice President of Activities

Initiates and plans Guild programming; maintains lists of current bees and coordinates with Bee Committee; Scheduling of Swaps.

Vice President of Geographic Outreach

Ensure regular social and enrichment activities throughout San Diego. Primary focus while guild meetings and most workshops are at Quilt in a Day is South, Central and East San Diego.

Secretary

Takes meeting minutes; records all motions made and carried out at all meetings; photography committee; posting meeting minutes; maintenance of communication vehicles.

Treasurer

Receive and bank all Guild monies, disburse funds as authorized by the Executive Board and maintain records of all funds. Prepare and present budget and financial reports.
