## June Lotto Block

*To coordinate the Blocks, choose a Grey for Background and Rainbow colors for the Mediums and Darks. Make One 12 1/2" unfinished Block at a time. Note: For our, SDMQG exchange, do not square your block(s) up.*



### Background

- (4) 2 1/2" squares
- (4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"
- (8) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- (8) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2"
- (1) 4 1/2" square

### Medium/Darks

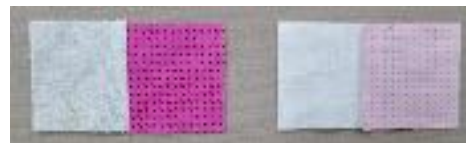
- (8) 2 1/2" squares

### Making the Block

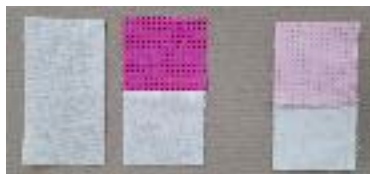
1. Lay out Medium/Dark squares
2. in a pleasing manner.



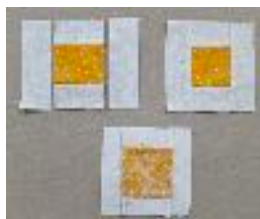
2. Make the Corner Patches first. Sew one 2 1/2" Medium/Dark square to Background square. Press seam toward Background square.



3. Sew 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" to the left side of the patch. Press seam toward Background.



4. Make the Side Patches. Sew one 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Background rectangle to each side of the Medium/Dark square. Press seams toward Background. Sew one 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle to each remaining side. Press seams toward the Background.



5. Lay out patches to complete the Block. Sew Rows together and press seams toward corner patches and center block.



6. Sew Rows together. Press seams toward middle Row.

<b>Background</b>	(4) 1 1/2" squares (4) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" (8) 1" x 1 1/2" (8) 1" x 2 1/2" (1) 2 1/2" square.	(4) 2" squares (4) 2" x 3 1/2" (8) 1 1/4" x 2" (8) 1 1/4" x 3 1/2" (1) 3 1/2" square
<b>Medium/Darks</b>	(8) 1 1/2" squares	(8) 2" squares
