for EPP
Charm Packs are great!

Bias Binding
10" x 12"

Backing
11" square

*Batting 11" Square

Supplies

Thread
50 wt Piecing/Applique
Perle Cotton #5, #8 or
Sashiko
Waxed Linen (Optional)
Hand Needles
Milliners #9
Crewel or Darners #7-8
Thread Conditioner
**Precut shapes for EPP
(6) Hexagons Size 1"
(10) Pentagons Size 1"
(8) Octagons Size 3/4"
Wonder Clips



* Batting is held together by a heat treatment, resin or scrim which is a thin layer of a denser fiber needle punched into the batting.

Low loft polyester, wool, silk and bamboo are the easiest to hand quilt with the Perle cotton or Sashiko threads for our 'Big Stitch' hand quilting. Cotton has a little bit more resistance and may 'beard' as the needle comes up.
